MARSHALL ZONE ACCESS



PLEASE READ THIS FLYER CAREFULLY BEFORE ENTERING THE MARSHAL ZONE

- The Marshal Zone is the areas between the spectator fence, the concrete and wire debris mesh trackside barriers. A course tabard is required for access and must be worn at all times in this area*.
- CLOSED TRACK: track closing is indicated by the Course Car with RED lights flashing. On a closed track, racing cars must be expected at any time. <u>No one must go onto</u> <u>a closed track</u> except a Race Official acting on specific instructions.
- **OPEN TRACK**: track opening is indicated by the Course Car with GREEN lights flashing. Persons and vehicles with a specific purpose may access an open track, under the control of Marshals and Race Control.

WARNING:

- THE MARSHAL ZONE IS AN AREA OF INCREASED INJURY RISK COMPARED TO THE SPECTATOR AREAS.
- BE ALERT AT ALL TIMES TO THE RISK OF FLYING DEBRIS: KEEP ONCOMING TRAFFIC IN YOUR VIEW.
- DO NOT STAND CLOSE TO ANY OPENINGS IN THE DEBRIS FENCE; WHERE THERE ARE TWO ROWS OF DEBRIS FENCES, REMAIN BEHIND THE SECOND ROW EXCEPT WHERE SIGNAGE WARNS OTHERWISE.
- TRACK BARRIERS MAY MOVE ON IMPACT, DON'T LEAN ON THEM.
- FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS OF THE RACE OFFICIALS.
- DO NOT CROSS THE BARRIERS ONTO THE TRACK EXCEPT:
 - ON AN OPEN TRACK; AND
 - WHEN ADVISED IT IS SAFE TO DO SO BY RACE OFFICIALS.
- PLEASE NOTE AND OBEY ALL WARNINGS SIGNAGE IN MARSHAL ZONE.

* except for Police and Security personnel in the track invasion strategy.
